THE WAPPY SPRING
Lindley Moor Road, Huddersfield HD3 3TD

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The name of 'The Wappy Spring' derives from the springs which run beneath the building and were used to produce the beer at 'The Wappy Spring Brewery' which was at the other side of the motorway and closed in the 1950s.

The word 'Wappy' (to rhyme with happy) is old Yorkshire dialect for quick or fast flowing, hence Wappy Spring = Fast Flowing Spring.

In Huddersfield there is a thoroughfare from The Market Place through to King Street, shown on maps as Market Walk but known locally as 'The Wappy Nick', which is presumably a quick "nick" from one to t'other! There is also an old "legend" of a tunnel running from The Wappy Spring to The Wappy Nick!
